**REQUEST FOR HEARING AND PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES  
IN RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF PROBABLE VIOLATION, PROPOSED CIVIL PENALTY, AND  
PROPOSED COMPLIANCE ORDER**

**I. Request for Hearing**

Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §§ 190.208(a)(4) and 190.211(b), TC Energy, on behalf of its subsidiary Great Lakes Gas Transmission LP, notified the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration on August 30, 2019 requesting an in-person hearing to discuss the alleged violations, proposed civil penalty, and proposed compliance order contained in the above-referenced Notice of Probable Violation, Proposed Civil Penalty, and Proposed Compliance Order ("Notice") issued by the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) on June 25, 2019 and received on July 1, 2019.

TC Energy, on behalf of its subsidiary Great Lakes Gas Transmission LP, notifies PHMSA that the request for a hearing related to NOPV 3-2019-1003 is hereby withdrawn.
