On September 4 through 10, 2019, a representative of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) on behalf of the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected the City of Coalinga's (Coalinga) procedures for the city gas distribution system. As a result of the inspection, Coalinga was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 28, 2020, which proposed amendment of your procedures.

My staff has reviewed Coalinga's amended procedure and it appears that the inadequacies outlined in this Notice of Amendment have been corrected. The CPUC will review the updated procedures during their 2020 inspection of Coalinga's procedures for the city gas distribution system.
